Call for abstracts for Posters



Poster presentations are invited from health professionals involved in the specialised field of asthma and respiratory health management and education. Posters may relate to research or the development and assessment of a clinical or education service. There will be a cash prize for the winning poster, which will be announced at the social function on Thursday 9 September.

The content of the posters should be current and address clinical, management or education issues.

The theme of the conference is Cough, Cough, Coughing. Cough is a symptom that affects people of all ages – some coughs are benign, others are more ominous. The conference will raise awareness that in people of all ages a chronic, wet cough is not normal and look at some of the many underlying causes and effects. It will showcase practical ways to assist patients with a chronic cough manage their daily symptoms.

The objectives of the conference are to:

- provide an opportunity for people who are passionate about respiratory health care to network, learn, share information and build relationships
- get insights from people who are working at the leading edge of respiratory health care and understand current change and innovations.

Poster Abstract Guidelines

All poster abstracts must support the conference theme and presenters must identify the particular theme that the poster supports.

The abstract should be a summary of the poster, up to one A4 page. Use Arial 11 font.

Poster abstracts must be submitted by email to conference@asthmafoundation.org.nz by 31 May 2010.

Notification of acceptance will be sent to the presenter by 20 June 2010. There will be one free registration for each poster accepted.
