You will be provided with the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback to the group about your experience in interpreting spirometry, and refresh your skills and confidence in spirometry interpretative strategies.

This course is only available to General Practitioners and Nurse Practitioners wishing to improve their interpretative skills. Practice nurses wishing to attend a spirometry interpretation course must have successfully completed a spirometry training course and have completed spirometry reaccreditation and provide

evidence of these and continuing spirometry practice.
