It's because of these shocking statistics that the NZ Respiratory Conference is so important.





## Terms and conditions





#### **1.0 Introduction**

These terms and conditions and the sponsorship acceptance form to which they are attached (together the "Agreement") set out the terms on which you agree to be a Sponsor of The New Zealand Respiratory Conference 2023 ("Event"). Exemption from any of the terms and conditions in the Agreement shall be given only at the Asthma and Respiratory Foundation's discretion and will only be effective if made in writing.

#### 2.0 Application

Applications for sponsorship can be made by completing the application form at the end of this document and returning by email to the **Research and Education Manager, Joanna Turner, at Joanna@arfnz.org.nz.** Bookings will be handled on a strictly first-come-first-served basis.

#### **3.0 Payment**

Upon receipt of your completed form, an acknowledgment will be sent to you. Included with this acknowledgment will be an invoice requesting payment. This payment must be received within 14 working days of receipt of the invoice to guarantee an allocation of space. Initial space allocations will be confirmed only upon receipt of this payment.

#### 4.0 Floor plan

A floor plan showing allocated space and stand numbers will be emailed through to you with your confirmation letter. Stand allocation priority will be to major sponsors first, then to remaining exhibitors on a first-in basis.

#### 5.0 Your liability

- 5.1 You agree to accept liability for the acts or omissions of your employees, contractors and agents.
- 5.2 You agree to indemnify us against all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages and losses (including any direct or indirect consequential losses, loss of profit, loss of reputation and all interest, penalties and legal and other professional costs and expenses) suffered or incurred by us arising out of or in connection with any act or omission by you or your employees, contractors or agents at the Event or in connection with this Agreement.
- 5.3 You agree to ensure you have appropriate liability insurance.
- 5.4 You are responsible for insuring the contents of your exhibition stand and all associated items.

#### 6.0 Venue

- 6.1 You agree to observe the rules, regulations and procedures of the Event venue.
- 6.2 You shall not hang signage or other material from any ceiling, structure or wall of the Event venue without our permission.
- 6.3 You shall not display or distribute the cards, advertisements or printed materials of other entities that are not Sponsors/Exhibitors at the Event without our permission.
- 6.4 Security services will not be provided at the Event, we therefore advise that you do not leave valuables unattended or unsecured at any time.

#### 7.0 Limitation of liability

- 7.1 To the extent permitted at law, we will not be liable for any loss, cost, expense or damage suffered by you or any other person in relation to this Agreement or the Event.
- 7.2 We will not be liable for the storage or removal of Sponsor/Exhibitor material or any other collateral, whether this be to, from or at the Event premises.
- 7.3 We make no representation or warranty on behalf of any supplier or event organiser and any dealings undertaken in this regard will be solely at your risk.

#### 8.0 Intellectual property rights

- 8.1 All intellectual property rights in the Sponsor/Exhibitor marks shall be solely and exclusively owned by you, together with any goodwill therein, and we shall not acquire any rights in that intellectual property.
- 8.2 Subject to clause 7.1, all intellectual property rights in Asthma and Respiratory Foundation marks, the Event marks or arising out of the Event shall be solely and exclusively owned by us, together with any goodwill therein, and you shall not acquire any rights in that intellectual property.
- 8.3 We will not be liable for any loss, cost or expense you may sustain in relation to the infringement of any intellectual property.
- 8.4 Neither party shall knowingly do, or cause, or permit anything to be done, which may prejudice or harm or has the potential to prejudice or harm the reputation of the other party's intellectual property.

#### 9.0 Termination

- 9.1 Any request to terminate this Agreement must be submitted to us in writing. Termination of this Agreement is at our discretion.
- 9.2 If we agree to terminate this Agreement, you will pay the fee as follows:
  prior to 18th September 2023, a fee of 40% of the total sponsorship costs will apply.
  from 19th September 2023, 100% of all sponsorship costs will apply.
- 9.3 You will incur payment fees and collection costs for unpaid accounts.

#### 10.0 Cancellation, postponement and force majeure

- 10.1 We may, in our sole discretion, cancel or postpone the Event because of circumstances beyond our control, including but not limited to, an event of force majeure where such an event though not directly affecting the Event, may have an adverse effect on the success of the Event or the Event venue becomes wholly or partially unavailable.
- 10.2 If the event is cancelled or postponed:
- 10.2.1 We shall provide you with written notice of our decision as soon as reasonably practicable.
- 10.2.2 We shall not be liable to you for any loss, cost or expense, however, we may at our complete discretion refund in whole or in part any payment you are liable to make under this Agreement.
- 10.3 If, in our opinion, we can carry out the Event at another venue or by modifying the Event programme, this Agreement shall continue to be binding on the parties subject to any necessary modifications, including adjustments to the size and position of exhibition stands.
